- 9:00 a.m. Arrive at the Neal Smith Wildlife Refuge & Prairie Learning Center to learn about the history and significance of the Iowa Prairie. These hands-on activities appeal to the kids, yet carry a strong educational component. They will enjoy learning about this history. In addition, see more than 35 bison and elk roaming through the enclosure by taking a drive through the enclosure with a guide. The guide will talk about some of the prairie growing in the enclosure and about these magnificent creatures. Cost: \$50 guide service Time: 2-3 hours
- 11:30 a.m. Depart Neal Smith Wildlife Refuge
- Noon Arrive at McDonalds in Colfax for lunch.

- 1:00 p.m. Arrive at Trainland USA to experience an operating toy train museum depicting the development of the railroad across the US. Frontier, steam, and diesel eras are represented with approximately 60 operating Lionel "O" Gauge accessories still in their original state.
