- 1:05 p.m. Arrive in **Downtown Newton** for an hour of shopping. **Pappy's Antique Mall**, located on the South side of the Newton Square is filled with quality antiques and collectibles. *Bank Club members could spend more than an hour in this store alone! The entire downtown area is covered with a canopy in case our Iowa weather isn't cooperative. Newton's Downtown area is thriving with many stores including specialty shops for music, crafts, books, shoes, floral, and antiques.* (FREE)
