Art takes us to places we *never* thought we'd go.

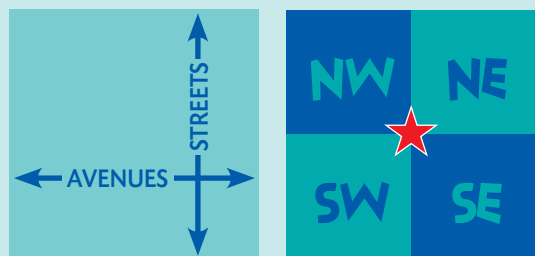

## GETTING YOUR BEARINGS

The City of Newton is laid out in an easy-to-follow grid and quadrant pattern. For the purpose of this tour, and to help guide you through the more than 70 installations of art and sculpture, here are a few tips:

- Jasper County Courthouse is the center point – located on the square at 1st Avenue and 1st Street (*marked with a red star on the large map on page 3 of this brochure*)
- Avenues run east and west
- Streets run north and south

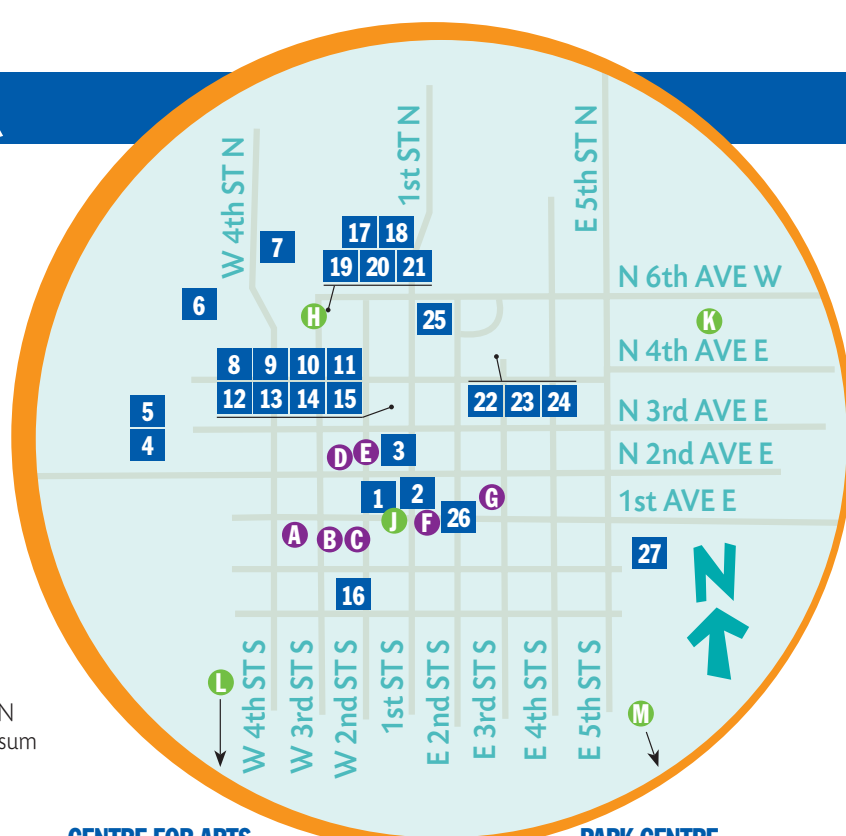
*For example:* If you're east of the Courthouse and north of 1st Avenue, you would be in the Northeast quadrant so a street address in that area would be East xx Street North, or an avenue address would be North xx Avenue East.



- The Newton Sculpture Tour is divided into three smaller tours: **CORE RING TOUR** – An exploration focusing on sculptures and wall murals in the downtown area, most within walking distance of each other. The **INNER RING TOUR** – A more moderate jaunt and an **OUTER RING TOUR** – Slightly more dispersed installations. For both of these more distant tours you'll want to use a bicycle or car.

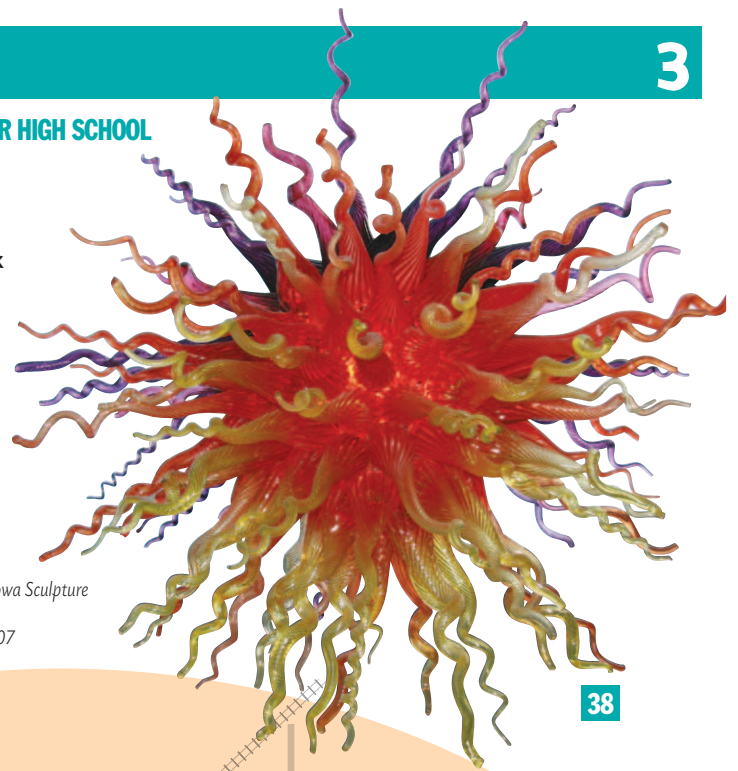

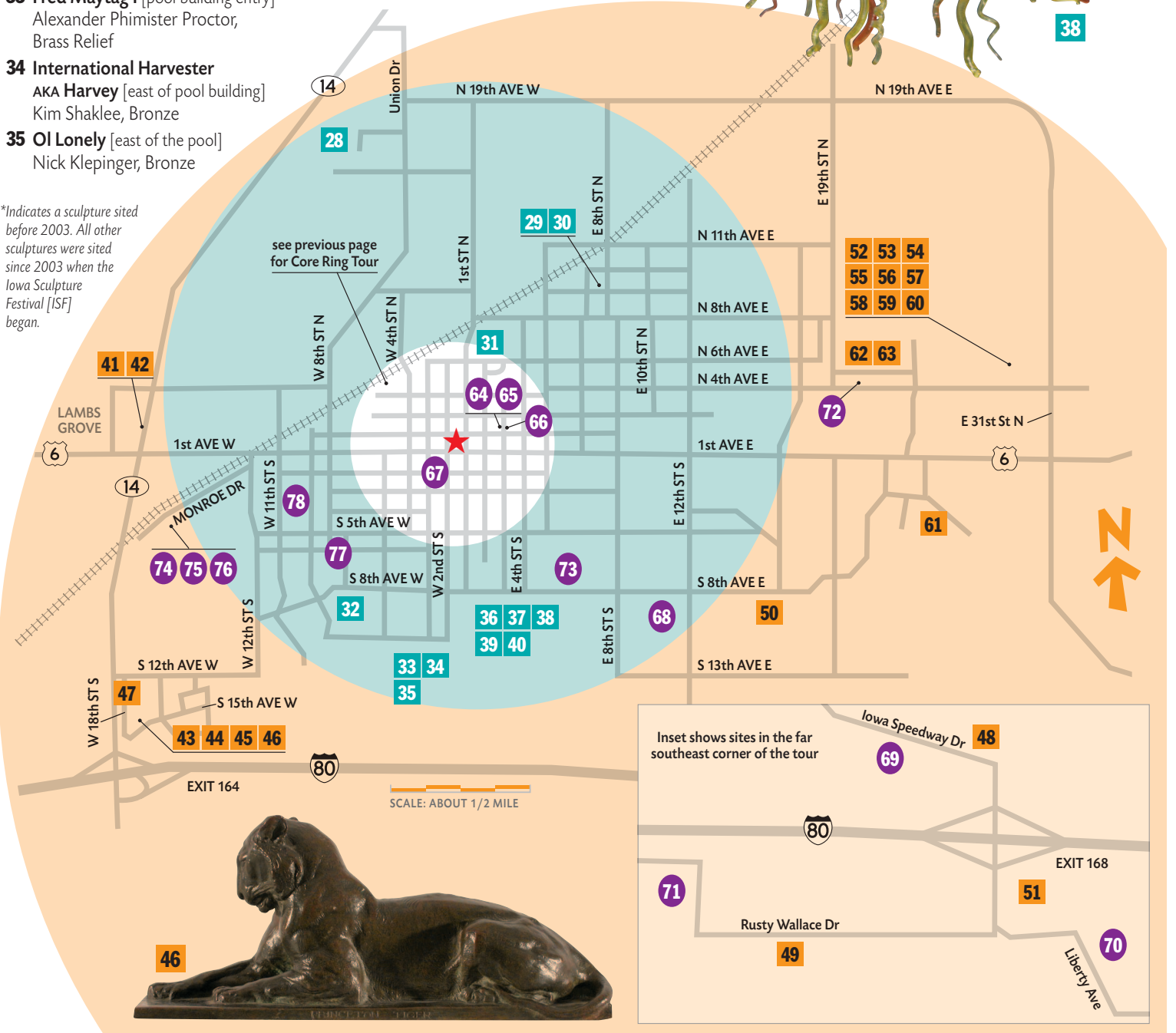
